8:30am All Other Classes - Start of Race (20hr time limit)

BLM STIPULATIONS:

ALL TEAMS - Bring absorbent rugs, mats, tarps, etc. to be used for fluid containment under vehicles in pit areas and during times that spills are likely to occur. A clean-up kit is also required, and can be as basic as a shovel and heavy duty trash bags capable of containing soil affected by a small spill. Spills greater than 1 quart **MUST** be reported to Race Officials or a BLM Representative. Your efforts in this regard are much appreciated, and will help assure a lasting presence of off road racing on public lands.

CAMPING AND LODGING INFORMATION:

Go to www.vorra.net to find links to local hotels in Fernley. Dry camping is available on the old Truck Inn property at I80 Exit 48 on the West side of Truck Inn Way .

Overnight camping is limited on the race course. Pit space is limited & cooperation to allow all chase crews access is vital. BLM Fire hazard level will most likely prohibit campfires during the event.

TRANSPONDER INFORMATION:

Transponders can be purchased for \$179 for a hardwire unit or \$224 for a rechargeable kit. A separate \$200 refundable deposit is required for rentals. A Credit Card number is preferred, and it will only be charged in the event the transponder is not returned.

- ♦ Car, Truck, & UTV Driver: 16 and up with adult passenger
- ♦ Car & Truck Driver: 17 and up in a single seat vehicle with demonstrated experience; upon review of VORRA
- ♦ Car, Truck & UTV Passengers: 15 and up with adult driver

TECH INSPECTION: Tech inspection is primarily for safety. It is also a time when all competitors can examine another competitor's race vehicle. If you feel there may be a rule infraction you must put it in writing and give it to a VORRA official. Official protest forms are available from the VORRA Officials. VORRA reserves the right to inspect any car at any time for rule book violations.

RULES: The VORRA rule book is available to download from our website.



It is essential that all persons participating in any event as a competitor, pit crew, official or course worker, as well as observers and spectators, realize that motor racing is a sport that is considered to be dangerous. Our rules are as stringent as possible to minimize that danger.

SPECTATORS, PIT CREWS, PARTICIPANTS, AND WORKERS ASSUME ALL RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE RISK INVOLVED.

SPECTATOR RULES

- Spectators must travel on established or designated routes to transit to start and approved viewing areas. Spectators are prohibited from entering designated pit or course areas, as well as from traveling on the race course at any time during an event.
- Spectators shall be directed to park on one side of the road to allow for an open travel lane in case of emergencies. Avoid parking vehicles on brush or grass.
- Spectators are required to maintain a minimum of 150 feet from the race course unless allowed in a designated spectator area determined to be safe from race vehicles.
- Motorcycle and OHV free-play are prohibited in conjunction with and throughout the conduct of the event.
